


How to set up a Facebook account

1. Go to www.facebook.com . You will see a screen like the one below:

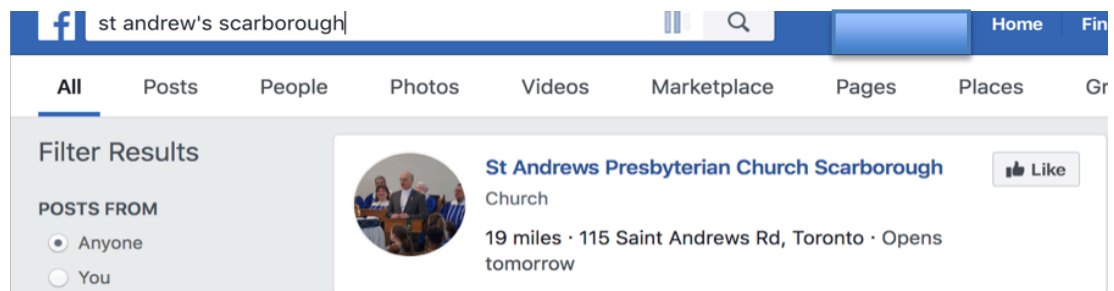

2. Under “Create a New Account” type in your First Name, Last Name and an email (or a phone number).
 3. Create a password, fill in your birth date, select male or female
 4. Click “Sign up”.
 5. You may now be asked to select a profile picture. You can upload one from your computer or your phone. Your profile picture will always be public. This means that anyone on Facebook can see it. You may choose a landscape picture instead of a picture of you, if you wish.
- On the top of the page you can search for names of people and/or groups.

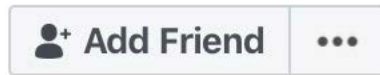


- You may “follow” a page or “join” a group. Click on the group title to go to the group’s page.



Click on “Follow” to get notifications from this group.

- You may send a “Friend request” individuals. They must approve these requests.



- Your home page is where your notifications will show up of groups that you follow or individuals you are “friends” with. This is also where your “News Feed” will be of updates from friends or groups.
